

#### Here's how to participate:

- I. Print the Maine Flying Trail Passport.
- Fly to and land at any five participating airports by October 31, 2011.
- 3. Receive stickers from FBO. Receipts for fuel, restaurant, and charts from airport can be substituted if unable to obtain a sticker. If unable to obtain any, logbook entries can be substituted.
- 4. Bring Passport with verification of five participating airport landings to Brunswick Executive Airport: by October 31, 2011 and receive two free lobsters from Long Reach Shellfish Company.
- Pilots must be PIC to receive credit. All pilots will be asked to verify their trips with their logbooks.
   Only one Passport redemption per pilot.
- 7. It is strongly suggested you call ahead to FlightLevel Aviation (207.406.2081) to let them know you are coming to redeem your lobsters.
